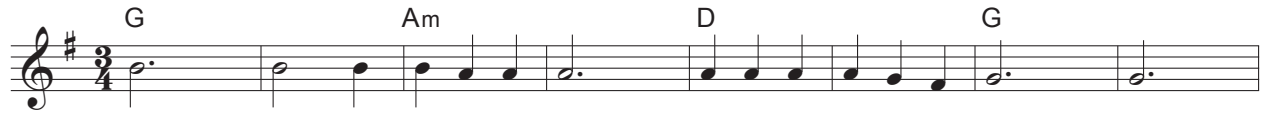


# Part of the Family
